## Dear/Annwyl Parents,

We would like to inform you of the work and activities planned for your children this term. Our topic this term is **Lights, Camera, Action!** Within this theme the children in class 2 have decided that they would like to design and make musical instruments, take photographs, perform shows wearing costumes, create music, make books of favourite movies, use a green screen to record videos and movies, record different sounds, use stop/motion animation, cook, make a camera and create, paint and use clay. Within this theme we will be investigating, researching, problem solving and completing art and creative tasks.

We will be developing our knowledge, skills and experiences within Wales' curriculum Areas of Learning and Experiences, which are: **Expressive Arts**; **Health and Well-being; Humanities;** Languages, Literacy and Communication; Mathematics and Numeracy; Science and Technology.

In line with the curriculum, 'pupil voice' is a vital component. Therefore, activities planned have come from your children's ideas.

#### Routines:

- **Reading Books –** please send in as often as they need to be changed.
- **PE kits** PE will be every **Thursday**, children will be required to wear their PE kit to school.
- **Seesaw** We will continue to communicate important information, updates and home learning tasks via Seesaw.

**Outdoor Learning: Our outdoor learning session will be on a Wednesday each week.** Some of the activities that the children will complete are: den building, nature art, gardening and planting and outdoor cooking.

The children will need to wear suitable outdoor clothing and a waterproof coat to school every Wednesday for our outdoor learning sessions.

**<u>RE</u>** – topics for this term are **People of Prayer & Lent to Easter.** Further information and suggestions for home activities can be found on the Religious Education newsletter provided. Topics will be explored through bible stories, prayer, class worship, church visits, liturgies, song and role-play.

## Maths We will be:

- Rounding 2-digit numbers within 100 to nearest 10
- Counting forwards and backwards in 2s and recognise odd and even numbers to 100
- Counting forwards and backwards in 5s
- Recording what each digit represents in a 3 digit number e.g. 265 (200+60+5)
- Subtracting 10 from a number within 100.
- Recalling multiplication facts for 2, 5 and 10 times tables.
- Adding two 2-digit numbers e.g. 34 + 23
- Finding the difference between 2 numbers by counting on e.g. the difference between 25 33
- Money adding amounts up to £1, give change e.g. Ball costs 39p, I pay using 50p coin. How much change will I have?
- Weight estimating and measuring using Kilograms, read scales.
- Time reading and writing O'clock, half past, quarter past and quarter to times, including 12 hour digital times.
- Shapes Naming and sorting common 3D/2D shapes.

## <u>Literacy:</u>

Please continue to read at home with your child. Reading at home is essential to support children developing their reading skills. In class, we are focusing on using questioning to show understanding of what has been read. Please ask your child a variety of questions to develop this further. Asking questions about the characters and what happened in the story will be very beneficial. Thank you.

# Letters and Sounds

Read and spell words containing same sounds / different spellings, ay/ai, ou/ow, ie/igh, ea/ee, oy/oi, ir/er/ur, aw/or, wh/w, ph/f, ew/oo, oe/oa, au/or, a\_e/ee, e\_e/ee, i\_e,/igh, o\_e/oa. Sounds sheets are uploaded to Seesaw Tricky words they, said, come, want, there, said, when, what, out, have, some, again, because, who, where, use.

**Writing:** continue to focus on using capital letters and full stops and forming letters correctly. A letter formation sheet will be sent home.
